

the EXHIBITION

The exhibition consists of a collection of 100 etchings from the Suite Vollard by the foremost artist of the 20th century, Pablo Picasso that belongs to Fundación MAPFRE and 44 paintings by the Spanish artist Joan Miró. Fundación MAPFRE in collaboration with the Office of the President of Malta and Fondazzjoni Patrimonju Malti (FPM) is offering this unique opportunity for those interested to learn more about 'Picasso and Miró: The Flesh and the Spirit'. The exhibition will open to the public on 7th April and will run until 30th June 2018 at the **Grandmaster's Palace** in Valletta, Malta.

This exhibition is part of a major international project 'Picasso-Méditerranée', an initiative of Musée national Picasso-Paris, which is an international cultural event held from Spring 2017 to Spring 2019.

Over sixty cultural institutions have come together to conjure up a programme around the Mediterranean work of Pablo Picasso. This journey, into the creation of the artist and across the places that inspired him, aims at strengthening ties between the shores.

PRIVATE VIEWING

The exhibition is open to groups for private viewing from Saturday 7 April to Saturday 30 June from 1630 hrs to 2000 hrs.

SLOTS

There are two slots daily. Each slot is of 90 minutes and includes the screening of an informative video on the exhibition with the tour of both the Picasso and the Miró exhibitions.

FEES

A minimum fee of €360 is charged for each slot of 90 minutes for a group of 20 people or less. An additional fee of €15 per person is applicable if the number of persons (20) is exceeded.

Proceeds from the Private Viewing will be in aid of the Malta Community Chest Fund Foundation. MCCFF supports individuals and entities to improve the health, quality of life and well being of people living in Malta in their time of need.
